



HOW TO APPLY FOR A COURSE

The first step is to fill in a North Highland College application form, unless you are a school leaver applying for a degree course (see later for more details on this type of application).

The application form is available from your local College campus or by phoning Admissions, The NHC-Thurso 01847 889250, or email info@northhighland.ac.uk or it can be down-loaded from the website www.northhighland.ac.uk.

You should return the completed application form either to your nearest college campus or to Admissions, The-NHC-Thurso. We will then invite you for an informal interview where you can meet with your course tutor and view our facilities. Parents or guardians are welcome to come with you.

School Leavers on Degree Courses

If you are a school leaver and plan to study a full time Degree, you should apply online through the Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS), the central applications service for Universities and Colleges by visiting the website www.ucas.ac.uk/. Evening Classes
